2. If you still owe **Stationery money**, please send cash or check made payable to Sacred Heart School in an envelope to school. Teachers will provide the students with the required school supplies.





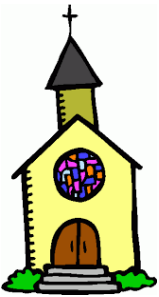
